



## DISASTER RECOVERY STATEMENT

In the event of a catastrophic interruption to the operation of the Company, the following processes will become relevant:

Customer's Site Engineers	Engineers are normally based in or near their customer base. Engineers are trained in multiple disciplines and continuation of field operations would be assured
Filtermist Employees	The documented communication policy would facilitate and co-ordinate recovery processes. Production employees are trained in multiple overlapping disciplines
Premises and Equipment	Temporary premises need no special foundations / lighting etc. Replacement equipment e.g. welding tables, welders & lathes sufficient to recommence restricted production can be purchased ex-stock. Tooling design is electronically backed up off – site.
Suppliers	The purchase system is backed up off site and could quickly be reinstated in any temporary premises.
Stock loss	Filtermist has a large international network of business partners making available large quantities of stock not held on the Filtermist site.
Business Interruption	The approved supplier list is sufficient to outsource all necessary components for short term manufacture of product.
Intellectual Property.	All IT based knowledge is backed up off site. Personal knowledge and skills are preserved through training in multiple overlapping disciplines
